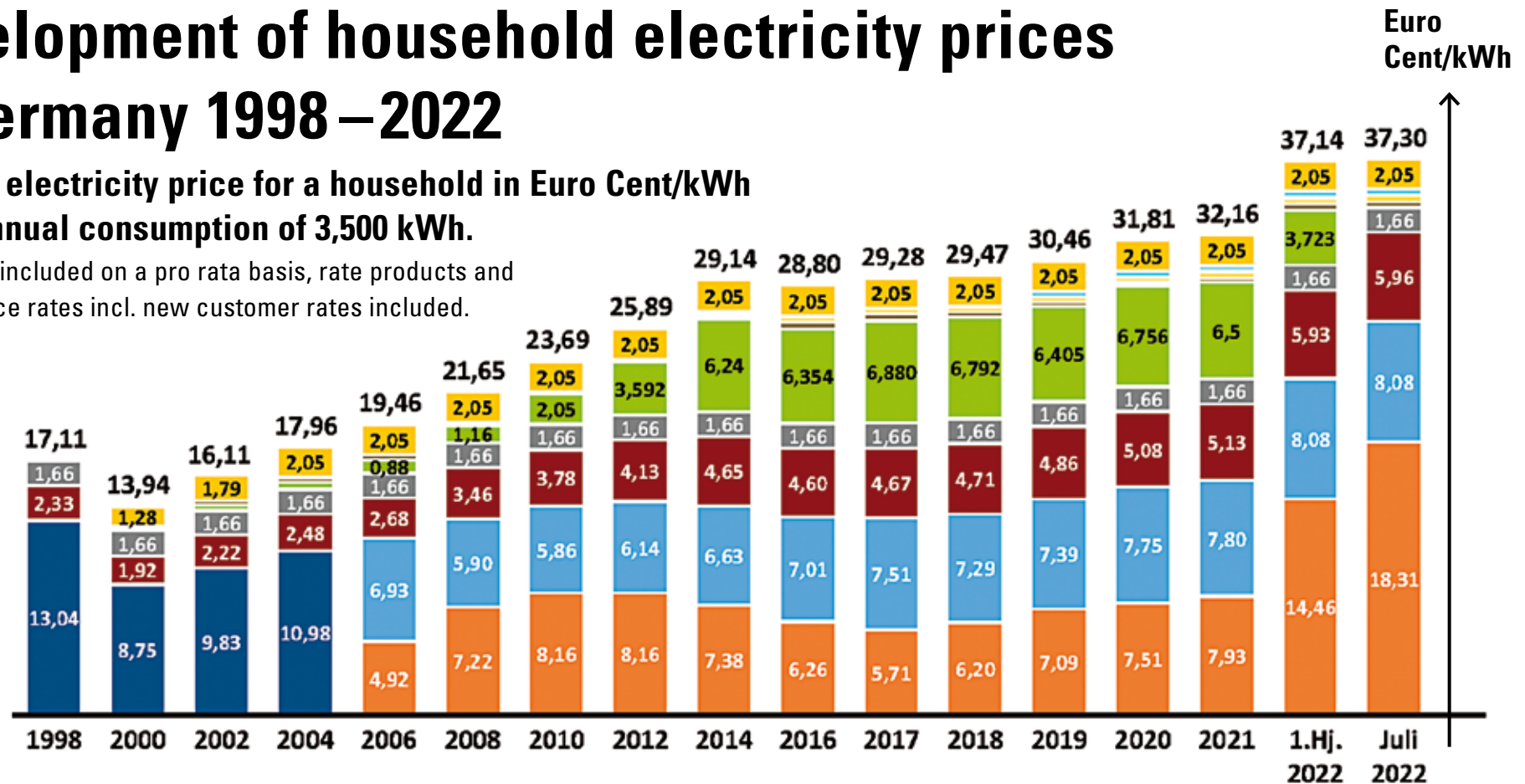


# Development of household electricity prices in Germany 1998 – 2022

Average electricity price for a household in Euro Cent/kWh for an annual consumption of 3,500 kWh.

Base price included on a pro rata basis, rate products and basic service rates incl. new customer rates included.
